**Hearing Protection**

General Rule of Thumb: If the area you are working in has noise loud enough that you are unable to hear someone speak to you from 2-3 feet away, **you need to be wearing hearing protection.**

The non-use of hearing protection may result in damage to the hair cells on the auditory nerves in your hearing system. If the exposure to excessive noise is minimized, then in time the hair cells will bounce back and the damage will be only temporary. However, if there is continued exposure to excessive noise, the hair cells lose their ability to bounce back and the damage becomes permanent.
